ORDER CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF DIRECTORS ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Lake Kiowa Special Utility District (the "District") has been duly created by order of the Texas Commission Environmental Quality, and the following seven (7) temporary directors of the District appointed by the Commission, to wit: Jess B. Maxwell, Jack Thies, John R. Anselmi, Margaret Dressel, W.F. (Bill) White, Joe F. Brockette, Joanne Snyder Dorsch, (the "Board of Directors"), have met and organized and have qualified to serve as temporary directors of the District by taking the oath required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District ordered that an election be held for and within the District on May 12, 2012, to determine if the District shall be established and to elect seven (7) permanent directors; and

WHEREAS, notice of such election, stating the day and place for holding such election, the proposition to be voted on, and the candidates for director, was given to the qualified voters of the District and all other interested persons posted notice in Cooke County; and

WHEREAS, the presiding judge at such election has made returns of the results of such election to the President of the Board; Now, Therefore,

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF LAKE KIOWA SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT AFFIRMATIVELY FINDS AND DECLARES THAT:

- A. The matters and facts recited in the preamble to this Order are hereby found and determined to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as a part of this Order.
- B. The above-described election was duly called, notice thereof was duly given, and such election was duly conducted on May 12, 2012, all in accordance with the Texas Election Code, as amended, Chapter 65, Texas Water Code, as amended, and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.
 - C. Only duly qualified resident voters of the District voted at such election.
- D. The returns of such election were regularly made to the Board by the presiding judge at such election as provided by the Texas Election Code, as amended.
- E. Such election resulted in the following votes for and against the following proposition:

- 1. The results of the above-described election is confirmation of the establishment of the District the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as a special utility district operation under Article 16, Section 59, of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 65, Texas Water Code, together with all amendments and additions thereto. The District is legally created with the boundaries described in Exhibits "A" and "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- 2. The following persons received the highest number of votes for director and have been elected permanent directors of the District to serve for terms which expire in the year set opposite their names:

- 4. The President or Vice President and the Secretary-Treasurer or Assistant Secretary-Treasurer of the Board are authorized to evidence adoption of this Order on behalf of the Board and to do any and all things necessary or proper to carry out the intent hereof.
